Sundays prior to Pledge Day. All fundraising will have been completed by the end of May so we will know how much more to ask the parents to contribute before the final workcamp payments are due 15 June.

- Workcamp: The church in Connecticut will ensure there are showers available for the adults during the overnight on the way up to the Sr. High site. Anita still investigating overnight location for the return trip.
- Added a Spring Break Hang out event likely to occur on Tuesday 26 March.
- Added a Lutheran Home Choir event where the youth would run a reception following the choir performance. Several choir members from CTK will be participating. Concert is 2:30 to 3:30 with the reception to follow. Punch will be provided but the youth need to bring and serve cookies, etc... Anita to canvass adults interested in organizing the youth making the desserts ahead of time and serving them during the reception. Plan on 50 people from the home, plus our choir members, plus our youth. Plan on departing the church around 1:30 and returning by 5:00 p.m. The home is in Rockville, MD.
- Anita will be thinking of other fun ideas for the youth.
