All pre-K through sixth Graders were invited to join an the Easter Egg Hunt Eggtravaganza that wass held on 1 April inside the church. There were four separate egg hunts separated by age group at the following times: Pre-Kindergarten - 1:00 to 1:30; Kindergarten to 2nd grade - 1:45 to 2:15; 3rd and 4th grade - 2:30 to 3:00; and 5th and 6th grade - 3:15 to 3:45. Children were asked to bring their own basket to collect the eggs. Cost is \$1.00 per child. There was good attendance by the Pre-K through 2<sup>nd</sup> grade; however, only 3 fourth graders showed up and no 5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> graders showed. Steffanie McKay organized the event as part of her Silver Award for Girl Scouts.
