

## Christ the King Youth Committee Event Report

**Event:** USS Enterprise

**Date:** 28/29 October 2000

**Location:** Naval Station, Norfolk, VA

**Time:** Departed church at 1700 on 10/28/00; returned 1600 on 10/29/00

**Attendance:** 10 Youth and 4 Adults (see below)

### Summary:

Ten High School youth and four adults from Christ The King traveled to Norfolk, VA to visit the USS ENTERPRISE aircraft carrier. The objective was to weave in spiritual learning with a fun field trip. To accomplish this, the group participated in the 8:00 a.m. Sunday service aboard the ship, held a discussion session with the two chaplains, and then took a tour of the ship. The ship had three chaplains – a CDR, LCDR, and at LT. They ministered to 3600 sailors. The senior chaplain, CDR Bert Moore (Bible Church) and junior chaplain, Lt. Dave McBeth, (Presbyterian) hosted us. The third chaplain is Roman Catholic. We left the church at 1730, stopped for dinner at KFC along the way and arrived around 2200 at the base. We had breakfast at McDonalds before going to the ship. We left around 1200 stopping for lunch at Subway and returned to the church a little after 1600. Costs for lodging was \$120. Youth and adults paid for their own meals and gas.

### Lessons Learned:

Use of the BEQ on the Naval Station was very convenient. The two way hand held radios proved very useful for the caravan drivers. The youth also enjoyed them in talking back and forth between the cars. Next caravan trip we should take two sets of radios: one for the drivers and one for the youth who could talk on a separate channel. This makes the long trips a lot more fun for them.
